Memo Wannall to Sullivan 10-25-62 recommended and
approved no attempt be made to develop Gibson as informant.
CIA was advised of subject's willingness to cooperate and CIA
advised consideration would be given to utilize Gibson on an
intelligence mission inside Cuba. (S)
