This document is to confirm discussions held between yourself representing Robert A. Maheu and Associates, hereinafter referred to as the "Firm" and a CIA employee representing the Central Intelligence Agency. If it conforms to your understanding of the agreement reached herein, kindly so acknowledge by signing in the space provided below.

- representative in Equadoral It is further agreed that all costs of this arrangement to the Firm including but not necessarily limited to the following, are to be reimbursed by CIA:
  - (a) A basic salary of \$900 per month.
  - (b) Costs incurred during the training of the CIA employee as well as travel costs for transporting him and his dependents and household effects from the United States to Equator and return.
  - (c) Representational costs incurred by the CIA employee including items such as entertainment of clients, secretarial and office help, office rental and office expenses except that prior CIA approval is required of the hiring of employees and rental of office space.

(d) Costs incurred at the direction and for the sole benefit of the Firm as opposed to those incurred for the establishment and maintenance of the cover are not to be reimbursed. 2 2123198

2. CIA will fulfill its reimbursement obligations by advancing funds, through a mutually agreed upon and secure channel, to the Firm in response to quarterly billings submitted by the Firm. Such billings will indicate the general nature, kind and amount of reimbursable expenditures.
