August 19, 1962, January 12, 1963, and on June 15, 1962 was elected to Propaganda Committee of FPCC-TP Newsletter TP T-10 advised that on November 6, 1960 HINE said he had just returned from Cuba where 2,000,000 people vere solidly behind CASTRO. TP T-1 stated on March 31, 1961 that HINE's picture, taken in Cuban sugar cane fields where he volunteered to work, was shown on Cuban Television. TP T-1 also advised that on December 3, 1961 HINE pledged \$10.00 monthly to FPCC-TP, on January 12, 1963 donated \$105.00 to buy 115 pairs of shoes to be sent to Cuba and also once sent \$50.00 to Cuba for child welfare for which he received letter of appreciation from FIDEL CASTRO's personal secretary which he displays proudly. TP T-11 said on August 3, 1961 that HINE's name included on FPCC mailing list, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

MC NAIRY, EMMA D.

On September 20, 1955, IANIEL GEORGE HARRIS (new deceased), Severn, North Carolina, advised that in about 1948, HERBERT MC NAIRY and his wife were members of the Pro-ressive Party in North Carolina.

EMMA D. MC NAIRY, according to TP T-1, attended nine meetings of the FPCC-TP during January and September, 1962. On June 15, 1962, she was elected a member of the Propaganda Committee - a part of the Executive Board - whose function it is to publish the FPCC-TP "Newsletter".

QUIST, MARY

MARY QUIST has been identified by TP T-1 as a former member of both the Communist Party and the Proletarian Party of America (PPA) who assisted in the founding of the Tampa Bay Chapter of the Fair Play for Cuba Communist doctrines.

PPA has been designated by the Attorney General pursuant to Executive Order 10450.

RAYMUND, BERNARD (DR.)

Dr. BERNARD RAYMUND's name appeared on a list of persons identified as members of the PCC-TP by V. T. LEE, then Chairman of the FPCC-TP, according to information furnished February 13, 1961 by TP T-1. RAYMUND's name appeared on a stition sent to the President of the United States seeking
