ROSSELLI passed the request to HARVEY. HARVEY, with the help of TED SHACKEEY, the chief of the JMWAVE Station, procured explosives, detonators, 20.30 caliber rifles, 20.45 caliber handguns, 2 radios, and to boat radar." (49) HARVEY omitted items which could only be obtained from the U.S. Government because the provision of such items would destroy ROSSELLI's cover as a representative of private business. "HARVEY says that SHACKEEY never knew to whom

delivery was made nor for what purpose." (50)

The arms and equipment was loaded by HARVEY and SHACKLEY into a U-Haul truck and passed to ROSSELLI in the parking lot of a drive-in restaurant. (49-50). "The keys were then given to ROSSELLI for delivery either to MACEO, to VARONA, or to VARONA's son-in-law." (50) (Cont.)
