Dear Mr. Carpentier:

In connection with its investigation into the circumstances surrounding the death of President Kennedy, the Select Committee on Assassinations requests access to all files and index references pertaining to the following individuals:

- N.R. 1) MAURICE BISHOP, aka JOHN BISHOP, JIM BISHOP, and FNU FIRGAULT. This name is most likely an alias and this individual's true name is not known to the Committee. Bishop was working in anti-Castro operations in the early 1960s. He was also allegedly involved in a plot to assassinate Fidel Castro in Chile in 1971 with Antonio Veciana and Luis Posada.

- [] 2) WIROGUE - CIA agent involved in the ZRRIFLE program.

Accordingly, in order for the Select Committee to obtain truthful statements and ultimately testimony from these individuals, it would be most useful for the Committee to have a letter from your office releasing these persons of any obligations of secrecy they may have made to the CIA, or to anyone whom these individuals may believe was affiliated with the CIA.


Finally, this letter serves as written confirmation of an oral request by staff researcher Dan Hardway for:
