Dear Mr. Breckinridge:

In connection with the investigation of the House Select Committee on Assassinations into the death of President John F. Kennedy, the Committee requests access to the following CIA-originated materials concerning Luisa Calderon referenced in FBI files as third-agency documents:

1. a March 29, 1972 dissemination from the CIA [redacted] to the FBI's field office in Mexico City classified SECRET;
2. a CIA Information Report, CS-3/568/425, date of distribution December 12, 1963, Subject - Travel between Mexico and Cuba; and
3. CIA teletype NBR-855 73 from the Director of the CIA to the Director of the FBI, dated approximately during the last week of November, 1963.

Since some of the information cited in this letter is derived from classified information, consideration should be given to assigning this letter an appropriate classification indicator.
