

Reference is used to message, this Readquarters, file F-60317, dated 26 October 1957, subject: Georgi ERUG, and letter, your Region, dated 1 November 1957, file FE-021685, subject: Georgi KHIID.

2. (MICKET) In the debricfing of ENUG, he stated that he had been prioritated by Fru TELMIR, correct name Grigorii RONDRASCHOW, in Mossow Suring October 1956. MONDRASCHUM furnished information to KRUG comporting Olga PETROWSKY and Tatonia ROMDHASCHOW. In addition, HRUG was furnished information concerning SURJECT who was described as an employee of the NTS Radio Station and sub-tenent of PETROVERT. At the end of Ostober 1956 - sorly November 1956, KEDO went to Frankfurt and, among other minulous, was directed to attempt to locate TURZEV and verify his residence with Fran PETROWSKY. ENUC stated be looked up the telephone musbur of PETROWSET in the telephone beek (previously checked and verified by your Region) and was informed by a female voice that TURIEV was on a trip at the time and would not be back until the following week. EAUS claims no further effort was ever eade by him concerning TURZEY.



L.(V)(COMPLEMENTIAL) It is desired that you contact SURJECT and under the suggested protest that Tatania EONDRASCHOV had made some vague mention of Soviet attempts to contact her after the redefection of her husband, U.S. authorities were interested in determining whether any further efforts had been made in this direction and if Tatania KONDRASONCY had furnished full details to U.S. authorities about the scope and extent of Seviet interest in her and her husband. Also, it would appear likely that the Soviete must have menifosted some interest in TURZEV. With this as a suggested basis for approach. it is desired that TURZEV be interviewed in detail to escertain exactly wien the visit of WALEFITAT (subsequently identified by the BIV as PERMITOV and probably not known to SUBJEST as PERMITOV) took place. Exact description should be obtained of the other personality who accompanied "VALENTIN" to the residence of KONDRASCHOW. Details of the disenseion between PERMINOV and KONDRASCHOW are desired. should be questioned as to whother any further contact was ever made to KONPAASCHON by any other members of the Soviet Embassy or other persons. He should be specifically questioned as to whether he had any knowledge of any questionable visitors or messages to Tatenia KONDHASCHOR during the fall of 1956. An attempt should be made to assertain if TURZEV was involved in any business trips away from the Frankfurt area during the first week of November 1956. Care should be taken to hide knowledge of the contents of the inclosed Frankfurt police report from TURIEV. If possible, TURIEV should be requested to provide a signed statement conserning his knowledge of both KONDRASONOWS and Hrs. PETROWSKY.

W(CONFIDENTIAL) It is to be noted that in provious review of Tetania KONFELSCHOW's visa screening file she made no mention of any visit to her by mashers of the Soviet Mahaney in Born, although she had revealed details of efforts made by her former husband to contact her. Upon completion of your interview of TURLEY, the material will be furnished CONUS authorities as a basis for further questioning of KONUSASCHOW.

6. (CONFIDENTIAL) Information gained from the mine queried the DAD element of OCA concerning SUBJECT discloses that TURZEY is no longer employed by NTB.

7. (WINGET) The statements of REUG are not fully believed. However, it is possible that ENUG a attempts to verify the residence of TURZEV Bay have been a prolude to the later contact made by PERMITOV in January 1957.

6. (UNULASTIFIED) It is desired that the results of your interview of TURING be furnished as quickly no possible.
