Interview: Luis Rabel, a former New Orleans Delegate for the C.R.C., was interviewed at his residence at 6701 Bamberry Street, New Orleans, Louisiana, phone 504/242-6387, at about 12:30 p.m. on May 8, 1978.

Subject is now and has been employed for approximately sixteen years at the Southern Scrap and Material Ltd., 4801 Florida Avenue, New Orleans, Louisiana, (504)944-3371. His present position is as Chief of the Marine Salvage Section.

The synopsis of the interview is as follows:

Mr. Rabel states that he was a delegate, by request, for the C.R.C., replacing Sergio Arcacha Smith, until he left for Venezuela on October 27, 1962 (verified by passport). He returned approximately eleven months later.

Subject could/would not offer anything of positive value to aid in this investigation. He reviewed the photo book supplied by the Committee (numbered in sequential order #1-110, with photos #72 and #73 missing) with negative results.

Subject states that he met Clay Shaw once at a party given at the home of an attorney named "Diamond" after Shaw's trial.
