Manuel Gill, alleged member of the CRC and associated with INCA (Information Council of the Americas),

Subject states he was a member of the (junta), a loosely organized federation which served as a liaison between various Cuban Anti-Castro groups. Most of their meetings were held in the home of Luis Rabel. He (Gill) knew Sergio Arcacha Smith, but couldn't recall where his office was located.

Subject states that he didn't know Guy Banister, David Ferrie, LHO or others of interest to this committee. His federation/group disbanded sometime in 62/63 and he went to work for INCA as a Production Manager for approximately three (3) years under the Directorship of Edward Butler.

Subject feels LHO was a trained propagandist as a result of his (Gill) analysis of his taped radio interview-- stated the original tape was placed in the offices of INCA.
