on 9/22/64, has not been known to be engaged in any activities in violation of Federal Anti-gambling Statutes. During the past five months Bureau agents have been contacting STONE at his place of business on numerous occasions and have developed in him a respect and admiration for the FBI. STONE has through friendly conversation with Bureau agents furnished information about his own past activities, background, and the present activities of several of his known associates.

UACB, no further action is being taken and the Dallas Division is submitting to the Bureau by separate communication designating STONE as a target under the ~~top notch~~ ~~Top criminal informant program~~ ~~program~~.
