Upon receipt of referenced Bureau letter on 7/22/64, pertinent information therein was furnished to the Central Bureau, Criminal Division, Italian National Police, Rome, Italy. On 7/23/64 Doctor ARISTIDE MANOPULO of the Central Bureau advised that all entry points in Italy are under instructions to exclude BRUNO from Italy since he is considered an undesirable person by the Italian Government. (G-1)(u)

There is always the possibility that BRUNO could pass through one of the entry points without being detected. Should this occur, the Italian police, pursuant to our request, will take steps to locate BRUNO immediately and place him under surveillance. We are hopeful, of course, that this will not happen, and that the field will be able to obtain information regarding BRUNO'S contemplated foreign travel so that our sources can be alerted in advance. (G-1)(u)

The Rome Office is no longer in possession of copies of BRUNO'S photograph, (having distributed them to our sources during BRUNO'S visit in Italy in 1963. *yes*)

Bureau is requested to furnish several copies of BRUNO'S photograph as well as copies of his identification record to the Rome Office.

Pertinent developments in this matter will be reported promptly to the Bureau.
