Concerning MIRR's claim that an air raid was conducted, U. S. Customs stated there is no confirmation, Radio Havana has made no mention of the claim, and Customs places no credence in the story.

On 1/18/65, Mr. JERRY BAUGH, Office of the Coordinator of Cuban Affairs, State Department, Miami, advised that office has no confirming information that MIRR conducted an infiltration mission and a bombing raid.

On 1/18/65, CIA, Miami, advised that agency has no information indicating that the bombing raid and infiltration mission took place. ~~(S)~~ (S) (U)

MM 639-S advised the alleged air raid mentioned in the press release is the same plan as reported in referenced Miami airtel to Bureau 1/14/65; however, MM 639-S did not participate. ~~(S)~~ (U)

EVELIO ALPIZAR, Key Source, advised he had no information concerning the alleged air raid and did not participate in it.

On 1/18/65, U. S. State Dept. in Miami issued a press release saying it "tends to doubt that such a raid even took place."

On 1/19/65, FAA, Miami, advised that agency has no information concerning the alleged raid.

Miami will maintain contact with local federal agencies and informants concerning this matter and will keep the Bureau advised.
