NOTE:

Subject, Cuban refugee and pilot, has participated in militant anti-Castro activities including bombing and leaflet-dropping missions over Cuba in the past. In 1959 and 60 he was hospitalized because of mental condition but in February 1964, physician who treated him believed he had recovered. In 1963 he furnished reliable information on two occasions which resulted in thwarting of two attempted bombing attacks of Cuba by anti-Castro forcest.

By letter 3/9/64 we dented Miami authorities to designate subject as PSI because we felt that, although he was cooperating at this time, background indicated he could change his cooperative attitude and participate in some militant anti-Castro activities without our knowledge. Migmi that his history of past mental instability and propensity to become involved in anti-Castro matters would make him difficult to control. Miami, however, was authorized to accept data subject might volunteer.

Miami airtel 3/26/64 noted Movimiento Insurrecional de Revolucionario Recuperacion (MIRR) is cooperating with Comandos L, both anti-Castro organizations which have been involved in attacks against Cuba. MIRR is planning new attacks on Cuba which will involve sea attack on Soviet vessel off coast of Florida and air attack on sugar areas in Cuba. MIRR is depending on subject to handle problems dealing with obtaining of a plane. Subject also learned that Comandos L is planning independent boat raid on Cuba in immediate future and subject is endeavoring to obtain additional information. Miami office has paid subject actual of \$400 to date (\$200 on SAC authority and an additional \$200 on Bureau authority) and has requested authority to pay subject up to an additional \$200. Miami has also requested authority, in view of new information from informant, to designate him as PSI. It is believed we should authorize the \$200 but take same position as we did before concerning his development as PSI.

BOSCH is depending upon ALPIZAR to assist him in carrying out these new plans. He again desires ALPIZAR to serve as the plane pilot, and to assist DOSCH and another Cuba, LAREDO RODRIGUEZ, in transporting arms and explosives to Andros Island in the Bahamas for concealment. BOSCH plans to set up a base on Andros Island for his boat and the plane, neither of which has yet been acquired. He desires ALPIZAR to handle the problem of obtaining an Aero-Commander plane.

BOSCH has told ALPIZAR he plans to use the boat in attacking a Russian vessel off the coast of Florida, and the plane for bombing sugar centrals in Cuba.

BOSCH told ALPIZAR he has decided not to deal with any Americans, such as WILLIAM JOHNSON and CHARLES BUSCH, both of whom were involved in preparations for the 12/28/63 raid. BOSCH has indicated complete confidence in ALPIZAR, who has been very adroit in avoiding suspicion.

ALPIZAR also has learned from BOSCH that the Comandos L group is planning an independent raid against Cuba by boat in the immediate future. ALPIZAR stands a good chance of obtaining more info about this by continuing his association with BOSCH.

(Miami has advised U.S. Customs about the above developments pertaining to raids, and is in process of preparing a communication for the Bureau suitable for dissemination.)

ALPIZAR believes that BOSCH is interested in promoting these raids primarily for the purpose of raising money. BOSCH plans the raids, but does not share any personal

risk. ALPIZAR doubts the value of any such raid as planned by BOSCH. He also has confidence in the FBI and believes it is his duty to cooperate.

In order for ALPIZAR to acquire this information he has to associate with BOSCH at the expense of neglecting his personal affairs. He is in the business of repairing air conditioners and other electrical equipment. He also gives private flying lessons. He has gotten behind in some of his expenses, and faces loss of his telephone service. He will be unable to continue close association with BOSCH at this critical time unless he can be compensated for his loss of time.

This office, to date, has paid him a total of \$350.00 out of a total \$400.00 authorized by the Bureau. An additional \$50.00 will be paid to him 3/27/64, which will exhaust the current authorization.

Alpizar already has proved his productivity and reliability. His position with BOSCH is unique because of his qualifications as a pilot and a veteran of previous raids. It is because of his background as a man of action and adventurer that he is able to cultivate the confidence of BOSCH. Miami feels these characteristics should be regarded as an advantage in assessing him as a PSI.

With regard to ALPIZAR's treatment in the psychiatric section of Jackson Memorial Hospital, Miami, in 1959 and again in 1960, it is noted his doctor, MIGUEL A. MORA, who was also his doctor at the time of his confinement, advised on 2/11/64 that ALPIZAR has recovered from his previous state of depression, and is leading a normal life, unlikely to have a recurrence of his previous state of depression.
