## MOVIMIENTO INSURRECCIONAL DE RECUPERACION REVOLUCIONARIA (MIRR)

Angel Gutierrez, representative of Movimiento Revolucionario 30 de Noviembre (30th of November Revolutionary Movement)

TP T-l advised that the Cuban Club facilities were utilized by another anti-Castro group on July 4, 1965, at which time there had been a telephone call advising of a bomb placed in the building. This necessitated police search of the building which resulted negatively. However, in view of this, the directors of the Cuban Club had established a policy not to make their facilities available to Cuban groups unless the majority of local groups petitioned the group. For this reason, according to TP T-1, the long list of delegates on the petitioning letter were set forth. He pointed out, however, that this list included primarily those organizations who met with or were closely associated in Tampa with the CACALC.

On Argust 4, 1965, TP T-2 advised that Dr. Orlands Bosch Avila, head of an anti-Castro revolutionary organization of Cuban Exiles known as the MIRR, was planning to visit Tampa from August 12 - 14, 1965. A private meeting is scheduled on August 12 at the office of CACALC, which is the residence of Enrique Someillan, representative of the MIRR in Tampa. This meeting will be for the purpose of organizing the program for a public meeting to be held Saturday, August 14, 1965, at the Cuban Club in Tampa. It is planned at this time to show movies of the attempted sabotage of a Cuban vessel, "Arecelio Iglesias", in Panama.

TP T-2 stated that approximately 10 to 12 persons are expected from Miami and a group from Orlando, Florida, are expected to participate although they are not officially recognized delegates of the MIRR.

TP T-2 furnished the following list of individuals who are expected to attend the meeting, August 14, 1965:
