/ MM T-1 is RAMON MACHADO, who furnished information on 6-12-64, to CHRIS LAWRENCE, Army Operational Survey Unit at Miami. MACHADO is in the employ of the Army and has, until his recent resignation, been a radio operator for the DRE.

/MM T-2 is CIA Information Cable referred to in the reference of this letter. (\mathcal{U})

MM T-3 is PSI-UD ANGEL FELIX YERGO, a Cuban exile who Mad been residing in the Dominican Republic.

On 6-18-64, JOSEPH VIDAL, CIA, Miami, was contacted to determine if CIA had an operational interest in the DRE action described in the CIA Information Cable dated 6-12-64. It was pointed out to Mr. VIDAL that by letter dated 6-3-64, U. S. Customs, Miami, had advised of the "Control Departure" of the motor vessel "Susan Ann" from Miami for the Dominican Republic. Mr. VIDAL stated that CIA had no interest in the DRE operation described in the Information Cable and that "Control Departure" did not mean that CIA was directing the departure.

On 6-18-64, Mr. STANLEY SCHACHTER of U. S. Customs, Miami, stated Mr. VIDAL had contacted him to clarify the meaning of "Control Departure" and Mr. SCHACHTER agreed that it was a routine inspection of a departing vessel and did not infer that there was a U. S. Government operational interest. He stated the U. S. Customs letter of 6-3-64, advising of the departure of the "Susan Ann" from Miami was classified Secret because it reflected the issuance of re-entry permits to the Cuban exiles on the authority of the Office of the Coordinator of Cuban Affairs at Miami. Mr. SCHACHTER stated that he had previously informed Mr. VIDAL that the movement of the "Susan Ann" and its crew did not involve the military action against Soviet or
