#### D Miscellaneous Communist Party Activities

T-8 advised that JOHN PITTMAN met and talked with JOSEPH SVOBODA, Press Attache, Czechoslovakian Legation to the United Nations, on the street in front of Klein's Department Store, 6 Union Square, New York City, on October 21, 1954.

The "Daily Worker" of November 25, 1954, on page eight, column two, carried an advertisement as follows:

"A Tribute to ANDREI VISHINSKY, the Man, the Diplomat, the Scholar -- with LEON JOSEPHSON, JOHN PITTMAN, ALEXANDER TRACHTENBERG, Jefferson School, 575 Sixth Avenue, Sunday November 28 at 8 p.m., \$1.00."

ANDREI VISHINSKY was the Soviet Delegate to the United Nations who died in New York City in November, 1954.
