PCI SINCERE HEART reported PETER MAGGIO received letter from Italy within recent past. Details not yet available.

PH 614-C-TE advised, 4/11/63, he talked with PETER MAGGIO on evening 4/10/63 and again on morning 4/11/63. On 4/11/63, PETER asked if source had collected some money. PETER could have asked question previous evening, leading source to believe PETER had been in contact with BRUNO between PH 614-C-TE's two meetings with PETER.
