This report has been delayed due to the preoccupation of the preparing Special Agent with other pressing matters in connection with the Criminal Intelligence Program and due to the dearth of information of pertinence concerning subject, as is indicated in the details of this report.

During the period 3/6/64 to 7/22/64, PG 713-C* was in operation, and this informant was in a position from which he could furnish information directly from the business office of SAMUEL MANNARINO. However, during this period absolutely no information of pertinence was developed. The informant was discontinued on the latter date due to the imminence of the razing of SAMUEL MANNARINO's office building in connection with the New Kensington, Pa., redevelopment program.

During the period of this report, close liaison was maintained with representatives of the Intelligence Division, IRS, Pittsburgh, Pa., who have a continuing investigation underway concerning subject.

The observation of subject's car on 7/22/64 was made by SA DONALD G. FISCHER.
