This report has been delayed due to the preoccupation of the preparing SA with other important matters in connection with the Criminal Intelligence Program, and due to the dearth of information of pertinence concerning subject as indicated in the details of this report.

During the period of this report, close liaison has been maintained with representatives of the Intelligence Division, IRS, Pittsburgh, Pa., who have a continuing investigation underway concerning subject.

Due to subject's incarceration in USP, Lewisburg, Pa., for a minimum period of four months, and unless something occurs which necessitates faster reopening, this case is being placed in a pending inactive status until the first of January, 1965, UACB.
