ReTPlet to Bureau, dated 2/28/66, and to Miami, dated 4/29/66.

Continued contact with TP 52-S, PSI VICTOR PASETTI, and TP 262-S has failed to reflect any organized activity of captioned organization in the Tampa area.

On 5/27/66, TP 52-S advised SA WILLIAM E. OGLESBY that the MIRR had no plans to initiate any bombing activity so far as was known in the Tampa area. This source advised that recently ENRIQUE SOMEILLAN, Representative of the MIRR, in Tampa, had delivered a letter to JOE HERNANDEZ, Manager of the local Spanish language paper, "Traduccion Prensa," containing a statement from ORLANDO BOSCH, head of the MIRR in Miami, to the effect that the MIRR was not initiating in any new activity against the Cuban Government, but that it had never ceased its activity in attacking the Cuban Government. This statement, according to TP 52-S, was made by BOSCH in reply to an article appearing in "Diario De Las Americas," Miami, some three weeks previous to receipt of the letter stating in effect that the MIRR was planning to renew its bombing attacks on Cuba. stated that the MIRR had never stopped fighting for the freedom of Cuba. TP 52-S advised that the remarks of BOSCH were never printed by the "Traduccion Prensa."

Since the above article was never printed, this information is not considered of sufficient value to warrant dissemination.
