On February 3, 1971, PCI HUCTOR FIGUEROA advised that he did not know either PARKS or SHARPIN to be involved in prostitution activities in the area.

On February 5, 1971, PCI LEON ROSENBAUM advised that he was not acquainted with either PARKS or SHARPIN.

On April 20, 1971, an attempt was made to contact subject at her listed telephone numbers 227-0694 and 227-4358. An information operator of the Illinois Bell Telephone Company advised that these numbers are no longer utilized by the subject.
