It is noted that following the meeting between EDWARD PECORA and EUGENE CATENA, at CATENA's residence, on 10/25/62, PECORA was observed to stop briefly at Gloves Esso Station, 68 West South Orange Avenue, South Orange, N. J., where he is believed to have made a telephone call from a pay station located there, which has telephone number SO 2-9648. This call was probably made around 10:20 AM.
