Enclosed herewith for the Bureau are 12 copies of an LHM dated and captioned as above with 8 copies to Miami in the event Miami desires to disseminate to the Co-ordinator of Cuban Affairs, Department of State, [CIA] Coast Guard, Customs, U.S. Border Patrol, and INS. One copy is being furnished to Jacksonville Office since original information indicated [MIRR was planning to sink a ship] in that area.

Copies of this LHM are being furnished locally to ONI, OSI, G-2, Ft. McPherson, INTC, Orlando, INS, Secret Service, and U.S. Customs, Tampa.

On 8/17/65 SAM JOHNSON, U.S. Customs Agent, Tampa, was contacted for any information indicating that ORLANDO BOSCH planned to commit any sabotage or to move his headquarters to Tampa. He consulted his office in Miami and was unable to disclose [identity of the police authority mentioned in CIA's memorandum] set forth in referenced Miami LHM.

On 8/17/65 JACK DE LA LLANA, Tampa PD, advised he had no information to indicate that BOSCH intended to move any of his operations to Tampa. He further advised he received no information from his sources that would indicate that BOSCH, while in Tampa for the meeting of August 14, 1965, indicated any plans for sinking vessels of any type.

It is to be noted that TP T-1 did not have any personal knowledge to indicate that the Spanish vessel was actually attacked by Frogmen as indicated by MIRR.
