SAMUEL M. GIANCANA, AKA, AR. RE MY TELETYPE TO BUREAU AUGUST 1, 1961. PCI RANDY BURKE ADVISED HE AND PHYLLIS MC GUIRE WILL PROBABLY DEPART NYC ABOUT 6 P. M. TODAY. MC GUIRE HAS A RESERVATION AT BOX WOOD MOTEL, OWINGS MILLS, MARYLAND. PCI SAID MC GUIRE NEVER STAYED AT THIS MOTEL PREVIOUSLY AND IN EVENT IT IS NOT FIRST CLASS MAY MOVE TO A BETTER MOTEL NEARBY. PCI DOES NOT KNOW PURPOSE OF HER TRIP OR IF SHE PLANS TO MEET SUBJECT AT MOTEL. COPIES MAILED TO NEWARK AND PHILADELPHIA FOR INFORMATION. GIANCANA SHOULD BE CONSIDERED ARMED AND DANGEROUS.
