Due to the sensitive nature of this Informant care should be utilized in the dissemination of this information.

DE 919-C* advised on 12/10/63, that ANTHONY GIACALONE had stated that NICK DITTA was scheduled to kill an individual with a shotgun. According to the Informant, it was believed that this individual might be TONY TOCCO. According to the Informant, GIACALONE mentioned the "old man" and this might possibly refer to SAM PERRONE. Also mentioned was PETE LOMBARDO. According to the Informant, this shooting was possibly to take place on Sunday night at approximately 10:00 P.M. and would be in a washroom at the gas station. Informant stated that DITTA would enter the gas station prior to this time and remove the ~~pieces~~ from electrical fuse box so that the lights would not go on after the intended victim and possibly a second victim were in the building and unable to turn on the lights, DITTA would then shoot them with his shotgun.

RECOMMENDATION

The above information was furnished to INS since they have an Informant by the name of ANTHONY TOCCO and it was also furnished to the Detroit Police Department CIB, at a later date, upon instructions of the Bureau.
