J., had been in the office of Local 910, IBT, in New York within the past week talking to MILTON SILVERMAN, General Manager of Local 810. SANCHEZ was unable to overhear the entire conversation, but was able to hear enough to get the impression that REGER was shaking down Montauk Associates in some way. REGER was overheard to make the statement that he "had a deal with them to gover up for them." SANCHEZ said that Montauk is located at 49 Troop Avenue, Brooklyn, New York. In addition, REGER was discussing the strike at the Duralite factory in Passaic, N. J., and mentioned that MIKR ARDIS, President of Local 945, IBT, was backed by TONZ PRO (ANTHONS PROVENZANO) and JOB STRETCH (JOSEPH STRACCI) in a PRO fight with the IUE at Duralite for representation. He said that ARDIS was getting jumpy and someone mentioned that he could not sleep lately and wondered if the strike was getting him.
