On Page 51 of the "New York Times" of May 25, 1963, an article concerning the killing of WALTER GLOCKNER was carried and mentioned that in June, 1961, ANTHONY CASTELLITO, Secretary-Treasurer of Local 560, International Brotherhood of Teamsters, had disappeared and is presumed dead. "Observers believed that his popularity had posed a threat to the PROVENZANO leadership."

#### Motive for SAL BRIGUGLIO

It is to be noted on July 3, 1964, NY T-1 advised that he heard from RICHIE BARRETT, who was incarcerated at the New Jersey State Prison, Trenton, New Jersey, that KONIGSBERG murdered "Three Fingers" CASTILLANO. CLARK stated CASTILLANO (undoubtedly reference to CASTELLITO) was the former President of Local 560, International Brotherhood of Teamsters, in New Jersey. KONIGSBERG was assisted in this murder by a SALLY BORGIO (phonetic) (undoubtedly SALVATORE BRIGUGLIO) who became a business agent for Local 560 right after the murder and as payment for his part in the murder.

On June 22, 1965, HAROLD KONIGSBERG advised that, as part of the deal for killing CASTELLITO, ANTHONY PROVENZANO (TONY PRO) promised SAL BRIGUGLIO a business agent job.

According to the "Local 560 Teamster," Volume 2, Number 5, May, 1963, which is published by Local Union 560, International Brotherhood of Teamsters, 707 Summit Avenue, Union City, New Jersey, one of the business agents listed was SAL BRIGUGLIO.

## Location of Murder Site

KONIGSBERG, on June 10, 1965, stated, "When they got him (CASTELLITO) to a farm in upstate New York, CASTELLITO was killed."
