Pursuant to Bureau instructions, a summary of information supplied by CIA is set forth in an accompanying letter.

It is of interest to note that during this investigation, GERALD PATRICK HEMMING advised that LUIS SIERRA works for CIA; Dr. LEOPOLDO NUNEZ advised that MEDINA claims to be working for CIA; CONSTANZO advised that CANTILLO is working for CIA and that LUIS SIERRA has been, and may still be, working for CIA. CANTILLO himself denied, when interviewed, that he is working for CIA. CIA, of course, admits that CANTILLO is working for CIA and has complained that this investigation has resulted in his being "blown" as a CIA source. It, therefore, appears doubtful that this alleged kidnapping conspiracy would have ever been conceived without CIA.
