Synopsis:

Instant organization presently not controlled by CP members, but CP members, Dallas, Texas, continue to have interest in the affairs of the Dallas Chapter of instant organization and attend its meetings.

DETAILS: At Dallas, Texas

Dallas Confidential Informant T-1, who has furnished reliable information in the past, on January 26, 1956, advised that persons present at a Communist Party (CP) meeting in Dallas on January 23, 1956, discussed activities of the Dallas Chapter of the G. I. Forum. Informant advised that PAT RICHARDSON, CP member in Dallas, while presiding over this meeting, urged CP members present to work in the G. I. Forum.

Dallas Confidential Informant T-2, who has furnished reliable information in the past, on January 26, 1956, advised that a meeting of the Dallas Chapter of the G. I. Forum was held on January 24, 1956, at the Recreation Hall at Little Mexico Village, Harry Hines Boulevard, Dallas. Informant stated that
