PCI Williamson previously notified our New York Office telephonically with respect to fight in Cal-Neeva Lodge between Giancana and Victor Collins, bodyguard-business manager, employed by Williamson to accompany his wife Dorothy McGuire. New York has been instructed not to contact Williamson for purpose requested as it would likely expose Williamson as informant. Las Vegas will be instructed to furnish lead-type information to Gaming Control Board for assistance in their investigation.
