**DETAILS:** 

#### I. RESIDENCE

On May 11, 1960, DN T-1 reported that he has been acquainted with JAMES M. DOLAN since 1946 and that he knew DOLAN as a con man and crooked gambler, who was convicted in U. S. District Court, Denver, in 1953 on charges of impersonating a Federal Officer, as a result of DOLAN's activities and attempting to "shake down" Denver residents for large sums of money. Informant stated DOLAN has served the prison term imposed upon him in U. S. District Court, Denver, and is now residing in Dallas, Texas, where he is reported to be an official of a labor union. Informant stated he has had no reports that DOLAN has been in the Denver area since he was released from the penitentiary.

On May 12, 1960, LESLIE REED, U. S. Probation Officer, Denver, Colorado, informed SA PAUL E. BUSH that after being convicted on impersonation charges in U. S. District Court, Denver, in 1951 and placed on probation, DOLAN violated his probation and was sentenced to a prison term, most of which sentence was served at the Federal Correctional Institution, Seagoville, Texas. He stated DOLAN was released on parole from that institution on February 21, 1956, and since that time has resided in the Dallas, Texas, area where he was under supervision of the U. S. Probation Officer, Dallas, Texas. He stated that DOLAN was released on parole on September 25, 1959.

It is noted that as of May, 1959, the Dallas Division reported DOLAN was residing in Dallas where he was office manager of the American Guild of Variety Artists.
