MIKE HARABEDIAN; FRANK MATULA, JR.; ET AL.; LMRA DASH IM. REURAD  
JANUARY SEVENTEEN LAST. REDISCUSS WITH AUSA HIS REQUEST FOR OPEN  
CONTACT WITH MATULA TO GAIN ACCESS TO RECORDS OF TEAMSTERS LOCAL.  
POINT OUT SUCH CONTACT WOULD REVEAL GOVERNMENT INTEREST IN THESE  
RECORDS AND IF MATULA REFUSES THERE WOULD BE STRONG POSSIBILITY  
RECORDS COULD BE MANIPULATED. SUBSEQUENT ACCESS TO SUCH RECORDS  
BY SUBPOENA COULD PROVE INEFFECTIVE. ASCERTAIN IF AUSA MAY  
DESIRE TO ISSUE SUBPOENA FOR RECORDS IN FIRST INSTANCE ON BASIS  
OF AVAILABLE INFORMATION. IN EVENT AUSA STILL DESIRES ATTEMPT  
TO OBTAIN RECORDS BY OPEN CONTACT WITH MATULA, DISCUSS FEASIBILITY  
OF YOUR OFFICE FIRST CONDUCTING PRELIMINARY INVESTIGATION AMONG  
DISPOSAL OPERATORS AND OTHER SOURCES TO OBTAIN MORE CONCRETE  
INFORMATION TO BE UTILIZED IN REVIEW OF UNION RECORDS. SURAD  
RESULTS OF YOUR DISCUSSION WITH AUSA AND RECOMMENDATIONS YOUR  
OFFICE.

former official of Teamsters Local 208, Los Angeles, that Matula and John Dorbish, officials of Local 396, were making collections from various employers and not reporting proceeds to local.
