Re Dallas letter to Bureau, 5/20/63; Bulet to Dallas, 6/4/63; report of SA WALLACE R. HEITMAN, Dallas, 6/14/63; report of SA THOMAS H. GREENE, Miami, 7/1/63.

Bureau authority is again requested to interview subject in accordance with existing instructions relating to interview of security subjects. Care will be exercised to protect the original source in this matter. No direct questions will be asked during the interview which will disclose to the subject the identity of the source. The interview will be conducted in a manner so that the subject will volunteer details of his connection with the establishment concerned. If this subject is cooperative, no affirmative steps will be taken during the initial interview to direct his activities, but a separate communication will be directed to the Bureau setting forth the results of the interview and requesting authority to recontact subject as a potential security informant or a double agent.

Pursuant to current instructions, the following information is set out (pertinent information which was set out in Dallas letter to Bureau, 5/20/63, is not being reset herein, but only changes and additional pertinent information being set out):

1. PINO resides at 1604 Annex Street, Apartment 211, Dallas, Texas. He continues to be employed by the El Chico Restaurants.

No known changes, and this information previously set out.

RICARDO ADELIS COBOS-RICARDO has not been located although inquiries have been made at Fort Jackson, South Carolina, and in Miami, Florida, the place of his last reported residence. On 9/20/63 HILDA GARCIA Cuban Welfare Department, Miami, was contacted regarding any current information concerning COBOS.

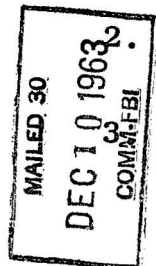

6. It is believed that subject may have informant possibilities in view of his reported former connections with the G-2 in Cuba, and in view of the large Cuban refugee population in Dallas. (X) (S)
7. No further information noted.
8. In view of information set out above, and for logical reasons to round out the information concerning subject, and in order to determine his informant potential, it is believed that the requested interview of subject is logical and feasible. (X) (S)
9. If Bureau authority to interview subject is granted he will be interviewed in the Spanish language by a Special Agent at Dallas to determine the facts of his background, his connections with Cuban G-2, and the extent of his knowledge of persons in the United States who are possible CASTRO agents, along lines set out above.
