COLLE stated he is in business to make money and his time is worth \$100 per day. COLLE was not belligerent to the interviewing Agents but said he would honor any legitimate Government inquiry if he were given time.

COLLE is believed to be untrustworthy and would probably enter into any business transaction where he thought he could make money and not incur any legal prosecution.

In view of the above, it is believed that an interview with COLLE at this time would jeopardize the case as well as ARNOLD RAYBER, the A & TT informant. It is suggested that New York consider obtaining this information through an informant or another technique.
