On March 15, 1961, ANTONIO AUGUSTO GARCES BELLA, 961 S. W. 3rd Street, Apartment 3, advised that he had been acquainted with LINO ELIAS since childhood. He stated that ELIAS was definitely anti-CASTRO at that time, and had always been anti-Communist in his thinking.

No information identifiable with this individual was located in the files of the Miami Office.

EVELIO ALPIZAR (S)(u)

On February 12, 1964, MM 492-S advised that he had been acquainted with EVELIO ALPIZAR since 1959. He advised that ALPIZAR had risked his life on many occasions as a pilot engaged in anti-CASTRO activities. MM 492-S stated that he regarded ALPIZAR as a sincere anti-Communist Cuban.
