The RU was founded in early 1968 and
is a militant, semiclandestine organization.
Its objectives, as set out in its publications,
are the development of a united front against
imperialism, the fostering of revolutionary
working-class unity and leadership in struggle,
and the formation of a communist party based
on Marxism-Leninism-MAO Tse-tung thought,
leading to the overthrow of the United
States Government by force and violence.

During the months of February, March and April,
