Enclosed for Chicago, New York and Alexandria single copy of Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA) report dated 5-18-70, with single copy of attached letter and envelope written by subject to Richard Hennighausen, DIA employee. Also enclosed for Alexandria single copies of DIA reports 12-2-68 and 5-12-70 in this matter.

DIA advised information from 5-18-70 report also furnished Secret Service.

Information in enclosures implies open advocacy of violence on part of subject to attain goals of Taiwan Independence Movement (TIM). Subject also apparently attempting recruit Hennighausen to assist TIM.

Chicago expeditiously identify subject as instructed in reBulet and ascertain activities in detail. Submit LHM and disseminate copy locally to Secret Service.

Alexandria fully identify Chinese residents of Shirlington House, 4201 31st Street, South Arlington, Virginia.

sent to DIA employee by subject containing extremely radical language, expressing regret that assassins failed to kill CHIANG Ching-kuo and stating that group's morale is very high now and in future "anything can happen." DIA determined that subject probably stayed in WDC at Shirlington House.

In view of subject's avowed propensity for violence, investigation to be conducted expeditiously and Secret Service kept advised.
