No additional active investigation desired concerning this matter at this time. In view of original allegation, however, alert established sources for any information indicating association between Bernard and Richard Frank as well as travel on the part of Bernard Frank to Toronto, Canada. Any information received should be furnished Bureau in letterhead memorandum form with appropriate recommendations for further action.

NOTE:

RCMP advised that vehicle bearing New York license
MM 5517 was observed in subject's driveway, Toronto, Canada,
sometime in early 1962. Subject has been active in CP activities
in Canada and reportedly associate of top-ranking CP leaders
and has facilitated passage of known communists to Europe. (S)
Investigation discloses Bernard Frank (registered owner of above
vehicle residing vicinity of Rochester, New York, employed as
lawyer and businessman. A brother, Richard Frank, is Security
Index subject of New York Office, however, no association
developed between Bernard and Richard Frank and no information
developed indicating Bernard Frank involved in subversive activities.
