Consular Offices: abroad. In this connection, if GALLO were issued U. S. non-immigrant visa in Italy at Embassy or Consulate there, record maintained there for four years. If he were issued immigrant visa at Embassy or one of Consulates, record will be maintained there 16 months and then destroyed. If other investigation re GALLO's entry to U.S. negative, suggest have Legat, Rome, check for post visa file.
