We are returning the attached dossiers. As you know, CAS, Miami, told us on 25 November they want to re-establish contact with Junco, SD-18872. This we are obliged to do as he is their source. I believe they will fail to establish a working relationship with him, but unless you people can persuade them to give up their interest, we are stymied. I suggest that we keep OI on SD-6653 and SD-19056, as they will enable us to perhaps use them and our OI as levers for further negotiation if CAS fails again.
