Subject: Conversation with Dave Snyder Regarding the Clay Shaw Diary

I spoke with Dave Snyder, (504) 899-6311, today regarding the Clay Shaw diary. I told him that the Review Board remained very interested in acquiring the diary for the JFK Collection at the National Archives. Snyder was cooperative, but said that he had not talked to the friends of Shaw who gave him access to the Shaw diary in quite a while. As a result of my contact with him, Snyder will initiate contact with the Shaw friends to get their approval to give the Review Board the diary for inclusion in the Collection. Mr. Snyder will be traveling in the coming week and needs time to call the Shaw friends, who also travel a lot. We agreed that I would call Snyder at the above number on Friday, March 28th to determine whether or not he had approval to send us the copy of the Shaw diary that he has in his possession. Based on their previous statements, Snyder did not expect there to be a problem. During our conversation, Snyder reiterated that he has a copy of the Shaw diary, not the original. It was made from a copy that the friends of Shaw's possess. The whereabouts of the original are not known. In addition, Snyder said that there may be some letters written by Shaw that are relevant for our purposes in that he discusses his being prosecuted by Garrison. Arrangements made for the transfer of the Shaw diary to the Review Board could be made shortly after my conversation if Snyder on the 28th, assuming he has been able to talk to his contacts.
