	full and 22 in part. These documents relate in part to the Fair Play for Cuba Committeeï¾€s reaction to the
	assassination of President Kennedy. Other documents relate to Oswaldi¾€s trip to Mexico City. In addition,
	the Board released 23 HSCA documents in full which relate primarily to David Ferrieï¾€s attempt to get
