Subject: FBI documents -- alert re possible search problems

FYI, in a conversation I had today with Steve Tilley about some documents (re Marita Lorenz/Frank Sturgis) that surfaced related to a Jim Lesar FOIA request, he pointed out to me some cross-numbering references that may raise issues of how thorough a search the FBI is doing through all of its files for all possible "assassination records". (In this case, 2 HSCA documents completely responsive to Lesar's request were not identified in the search for responsive records, apparently because they were in an "obstruction of justice" file. I've got a copy of the documents if you want to see them. Steve said he thinks this is potentially a big problem at FBI. Just wanted to alert you all -- please let me know if you have any questions.
