Per my commitment of last week, I've secured copies of various documents purporting to be indices of one sort or another for HSCA photographic materials. I'll hold them for you pending your return from New Orleans.I'm not certain what these documents tell us, nor have I done anything to try and sort out whether they are overlapping (different generations of the same data), exclusive, etc. They probably need to be shown to someone intimately familiar with the Archives/HSCA photo collection. I believe one or more of the documents I've collected may be the same as those given you by Steve Tilley earlier. Some, clearly, are not.In terms of retrieval of materials which may not currently be part of the JFK collection, I draw your attention to "Original Photographic Material to Be Returned by Hand Carrier" (attached by paperclip to HSCA document 180-10114-10402), as well as 180-10116-10386. The latter is an alphabetical bundled card file, which I have copied onto 8 1/2 by 11. I thought this might be useful since many of the cards indicate the "present" (circa
