Body: Prior to my becoming a member of the Review Board staff, I was informed by a former FBI agent that during the Clay Shaw trial in 1969, he was responsible for preparing a memo each day for FBI Director Hoover on what was happening at the trial. The ex-agent had a very vivid recollection of this assignment because he had to get into the office at 5:00 a.m. to prepare the memo, have it typed and get it to Hoover by 9:00 a.m. every morning that the trial was going on. I thought this information might be of interest.
