Chet, in three sections of the Agency Contacts database, there are two different blue titles for agencies and they basically stand for the same thing. Let me explain:1) There is one entry for "Federal Register" and another for "Office of the Federal Register." There really should only be one entry under "Federal Register."2) There is one entry for "Department of Justice" and another entry, much further down, for "Justice Department, Office of Information and Privacy (OIP)." OIP is a division of Justice and I think it is fine if it has its own blue heading, but we should probably call it "Department of Justice, Office of Information and Privacy" so that people can find it when they look under DOJ.3) Finally, (and there may be a reason for this), but we have one entry for "NARA -- College Park" and another entry for "National Archives and Records Administration." We should probably call it one or the other so it is easier to find. I know you didn't create these confusing entries, but I don't know how to edit the names of these things and I keep running into trouble with them - esp. with the first two (Fed. Reg. and OIP). Would it be possible to fix this? Thanks!
