NYPD was not among the local/state agencies you asked me to look at a while ago, but I thought I would pass on a piece of correspondence (attached to hard copy of this memo) from New York City Police Commissioner McGuire to Bob Blakey, dated 3/6/78, in which McGuire is clearly responding to HSCA requests for information. There is also another RIF for a later (June 78) document from NYPD to Blakey, re: Carlos Marcello. This latter document (2 page letter) is referred, but I can look at it on Tuesday when I'm down at Archives I and see if it provides any clues about the HSCA/NYPD interface. The HSCA collection also contains a cover letter and 3 page NYPD file on the "mysterious" death of Dorothy Kilgallen, Ruby witness and panelist on
