FYI, I've put in your box an interview with Gov. Connally on 11/27/63 (while he was still in Parkland Hospital) in which he claims he had turned, as opposed to was turning, to the leff and saw the President slumped down before/just as he himself was shot. As you are well aware, this contradicts his HSCA testimony and his Warren Commission testimony, attached (as well as the Zapruder film). The 11/27 interview doesn't reference the initial turn to the right and at least suggests that Connally saw the President after he (the President) had been hit. I'm sure I'm betraying my ignorance of the literature, but I've not seen this contradiction referenced elsewhere. Nor am I suggesting the contradiction is meaningful, just mildly noteworthy.
