Given my fairly regular need to conduct large document pulls at NARA I and II, this restriction will be a significant inconvenience. I don't presume to question its necessity, but in the no doubt vain hope that David's memo means something other than what it says, I wanted to confirm its universality. Does it mean that I can no longer take ARRB-generated RIFs out with me to NARA II, even though I transport them in a closed briefcase which is open only when I'm in a restricted space (Steve's offices) which the general public has no access to? (What if I double-wrapped the RIFs, in the same way that we would transport postponed/secret documents from, say, Archives I to our office?). Please advise, as I need to go out to NARA II tomorrow to look at a large number of documents and, if I can't take the RIFs with me, I will have to substantially alter (ie, add to) the document request memo I would otherwise send to Steve.
