**Subject:** CURRENT LOCATION OF FORMER MEMBER OF USMC

Anne, I'm working a military document issue (Oswald's DD 1173 I.D. card) in which Jeremy and David have both expressed interest. There are several seeming irregularities about the issuance of subject I.D. card to Oswald on the same day he was discharged, 11 Sep 59. One of the best ways to resolve our questions would be if the staff could contact the USMC junior officer who signed both the I.D. card and the service record entry which recorded issuance of the card. David asked me to find out the most complete version of this officer's name possible, and forward that to you so that you could draft a letter for the Review Board to send to the Records Center in Saint Louis in order to determine his most recently recorded whereabouts. The information follows: a. Name: A. G. Ayers, Jr. b. Rank: 1st Lt, USMCR c. Location/Job Assignment: Assistant OIC, Separation Section, Headquarters and Headquarters Squadron (H & HS), Marine Corps Air Station El Toro, Santa Anna, CA. d. Serial Number: 072172 e. Amplifying Information: Oswald transferred out of his last "regular" unit (PCS duty station), MACS-9 (also at El Toro) on 03 Sep 59 and joined the El Toro "H & HS" (i.e., the headquarters admin section) on the next day, 04 Sep 59. Oswald was subsequently discharged from the USMC by El Toro's "H & HS" on 11 Sep 59. First Lieutenant Ayers signed virtually all administrative documents for Oswald from 04-11 Sep, 1959. This is all the information I have on 1st Lt Ayers. The only way to definitively resolve our questions about this document may ultimately be for the staff to interview Mr. Ayers if he is alive today and can be located.
